G Premium Checking Service

H How to pay

By post to DVLA, Swansea

- You can use a cheque or postal order, payable to 'DVLA, Swansea'.

We do not accept post-dated cheques.

At a Post Office® branch

- If you use the Premium Checking Service at a Post Office® branch you can pay by cash, cheque or debit card. Cheques must be made payable to 'Post Office Ltd' and you must have a cheque guarantee card.

At DVLA local offices

- DVLA local offices also accept cash, cheques, credit cards and debit cards.

Do not send cash or blank postal orders to DVLA.

I Driving while we have your application form

Provisional licences

If you are applying for your first provisional licence, you must not drive until you receive your licence.

Changing the name and/or address on your licence, replacing a lost, stolen, destroyed or defaced licence, renewing a photo or getting a full licence after passing a driving test.

You can drive before you receive your licence as long as:

- you have held a GB or Northern Ireland licence issued after 1 January 1976 or one you can exchange for a full British one;
- you are not disqualified from driving;
- you have not been refused a licence for medical reasons or for failing to comply with medical enquiries;
- you would not be refused a licence for medical reasons (if you are not sure, check with your doctor); and
- you keep to any special conditions which apply to the licence.

Renewing a licence at age 70 or over

Once we have received your valid application you can drive before you receive your licence as long as you meet the conditions listed above.

J When you will receive your driving licence

Your licence should arrive within 15 working days of us receiving your application. It might take longer if we have to check your medical or personal details:
